An exciting and diverse range of adult art workshops!

Art in Reverse courses are designed for beginners who have limited art experience, or more experienced artists who would like to extend existing skills.

Each course utilises some of the magnificent and unusual resources found at Reverse Garbage – be inspired as you transform your ideas into imaginative art works using different techniques and materials. Through demonstrations and practical exercises, workshops will guide participants through the creative process.

Workshops will cater for 8-10 students offering expert tuition from established artists. Provided are reuse materials sourced from Reverse Garbage, except for protective clothing and your favourite brushes and materials.

Artists Tutoring at Art In Reverse

Vivienne Dadour

Vivienne Dadour has extensive experience over the last 25 years as a professional artist-curating, exhibiting, publishing and making art work. Her art practice, from 1996 to 2012 has been extensively reviewed in journal articles and books. A finalist in the Sulman, Portia Gech and Blake prizes Dadour in 2003 was awarded an Australia Council Visual Art/Craft Board Grant. In 1995 she completed a Master Fine Art degree (Hons Class1) UNSW College Fine Art. In 1996 was awarded an Art Gallery NSW Scholarship to study at the Cite des Artes in Paris and in 1999 a New England Regional Art Museum Research Scholarship.

Collections include the Australian War Memorial Museum (2005).

Ina's interest in artmaking has been varied but her current themes centre on the botanical world using various forms of printmaking and has been running private workshops demonstrating drypoint etching and embossing techniques. She has studied both in Australia and overseas and has taught visual art in high school, been an artist in residence and workshop leader for a variety of interest groups.

Sketch Group with Artist Vivienne Dadour

Tuesday 7 May to Tuesday 25 June 2013

10am to 2pm

A perfect course for beginner students who have limited art experience or experienced artists who would like to extend their skills. Starting with unusual resources from Reverse Garbage as subject matter, we will create interesting and exciting images while being introduced to the fundamentals of sketching while learning key drawing skills. If you're a beginner you will be guided step-by-step and learn how to draw using the principals of perspective, tone, texture, shape and colour.

Self Expression Group with Artist Vivienne Dadour

Wednesday 8 May 2013 to Wednesday 26 June

10am to 2pm

Explore your creative potential! Develop your own visual language while having fun!

This special course is designed to help students find their way into creating their own subject matter and techniques for developing a body of work from a single idea. Students will be guided through a series of structured exercises and directed to independent research that will explore each student's ideas while developing and completing a personal body of work.

Students will work from some unusual subject matter sourced from the Reverse Garbage environment as initial stimulus and be introduced to a range of techniques and mediums. By the end of the term, you will have gained further insights into your own visual sensibilities, developed your skills and have a body of work for exhibition.

Bring your ideas and any resources and materials you wish to explore and develop.

Art in Reverse Courses

HSC Visual Art Group with Artist Vivienne Dadour

Wednesday 8 May to Wednesday 26 June 2013

5pm to 8pm

This special course offers Year 11 and 12 students the opportunity to learn how to develop a body of work from a single idea. Students will be guided through a series of structured exercises and directed to independent research that explores each student's chosen theme. Students will be encouraged to be flexible and explore both representational and abstract approaches to their subject matter. This course is suitable for students who are interested in consolidating their core skills in the expressive mediums of drawing, painting, design and mixed-media. Bring your VAPD and any resources and materials you wish to explore and develop.

Printmaking Group with Artist Ina Burt

Thursday 9 May to Thursday 27 June 2013

10am to 2pm

An exciting course that will provide an individual approach for all printmakers, focussing on safe dry point etching with embossing techniques. Learn printing techniques including colour roll-ups and viscosity printing. Create your own personal visual imagery with unusual subject matter sourced from the Reverse Garbage environment.

By the end of the term, you will have gained further insights into printmaking with its endless possibilities. This course is designed for beginners as well as more established artists. Some essential materials will be supplied by your tutor (pay \$5 to your tutor on the day).

Courses run for an 8 week term, from 10am to 2pm and cost \$400. Book for a full term and receive a 10% discount. Pensioners and individuals who have joined the Friends of Reverse Garbage Club receive a 10% discount.

Casual attendance is possible if spaces are available, pre-booking is ESSENTIAL. Book and pay for a 4 week block or 4 classes throughout the term for \$400.

Course fees are listed in the Art in Reverse course descriptions are inclusive of GST. Payment of these fees is required to secure your place in the course. A tax receipt will be provided to you once your payment has been processed.
