About us

Reverse Garbage is a not-for-profit creative reuse centre based in Marrickville, in Sydney's inner west. We redirect commercial and industrial waste from landfill to a new life with educators, students, artists, upcyclers, DIY enthusiasts, tinkerers, set builders, window dressers, community organisations, festivals, charities, and more.

Reverse Garbage was established in 1974 by a group of teachers and community workers determined to ease pressure on the environment. Their plan was to divert industrial discards from landfill and reuse those materials in their classrooms. To this day, education is a major focus for our reuse resources.

The role

The RG Education team work with adults and children. We deliver a wide range of programs in partnership with early childhood services and schools. We also operate our own community education activities directly with the public at festivals, shopping centres as well as on site at Reverse Garbage.

Main duties

- Liaise with education and workshop clients
- Deliver workshops designed by Reverse Garbage in partnership with other educators.
- Develop specific workshops using reuse resources available at our warehouse that emphasise creativity and sustainability.
